35% of IT employers plan no change to their headcount in the second quarter of 2025



Among IT employers who are hiring, average hiring volume is set to decline by -57% vs Q1 2025



75% of IT employers report difficulty finding candidates with the skills they need


### Over a third of UK IT industry plan no headcount changes

More than a third of businesses in the IT sector plan to leave headcounts unchanged going into Q2 (April – July 2025). Meanwhile, employers who have indicated plans to change headcount in the coming quarter report an average **-57% drop** in hiring volume.
